Workers compensation insurance covers the cost of medical care and rehabilitation for workers injured on the job. It also compensates them for lost wages and provides death benefits for their dependents if they are killed in work-related accidents, including terrorist attacks.

Systems vary from state to state. State statutes and court decisions control many aspects, including the handling of claims, evaluation of impairment and settlement of disputes, the amount of benefits injured workers receive and strategies used to control costs.

In Texas, legislators passed a law on September 1, 2005, abolishing the Texas Workers Compensation Commission, transferring regulatory functions to a new department within the Department of Insurance, the Texas Department of Workers Compensation, whose commissioner is appointed by the governor; establishes the Office of Injured Employee Counsel which deals specifically with return-to-work and workplace safety issues, acting as advocate for injured workers; and allows insurers to create medical care networks of approved providers from which injured workers will be required to select their "treating doctor."
